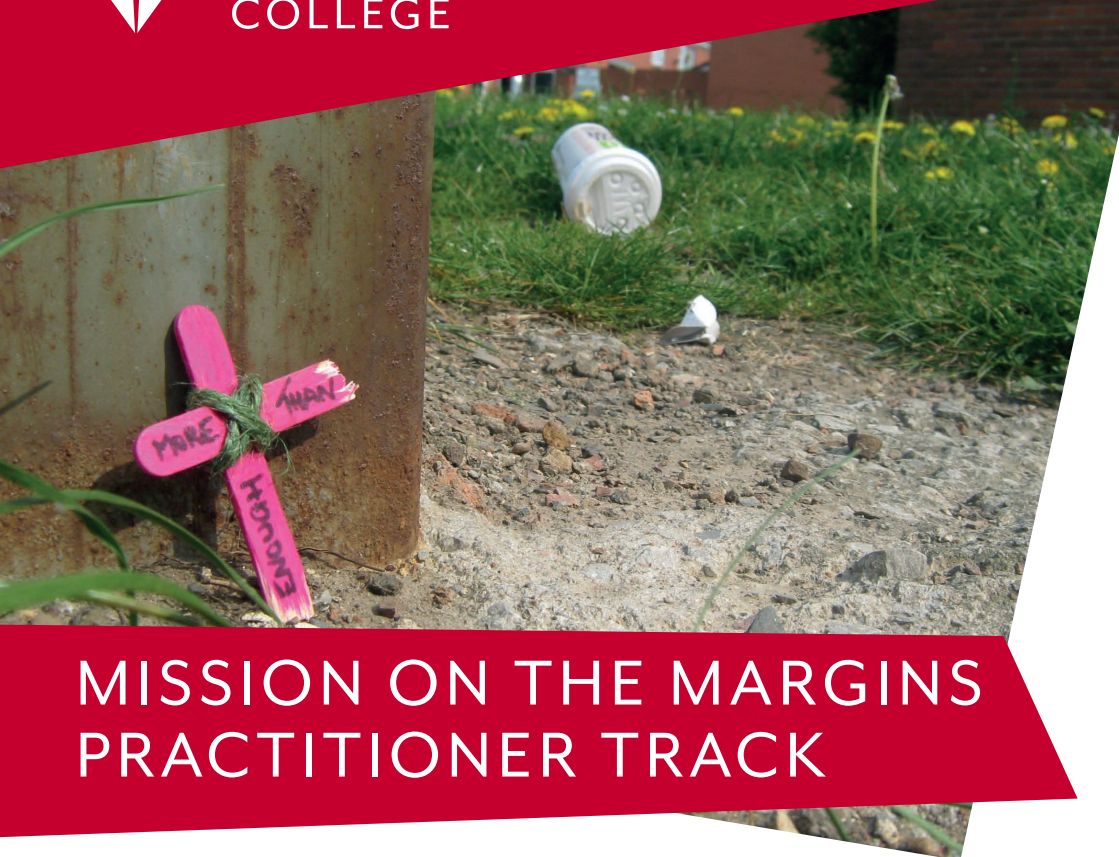

St Hild Practitioner Tracks combine an accompanied learning process with module options in urban and rural mission, ethics, church planting and theological reflection. Partnering with Urban Life, and linked to a wider network of practitioners, learning will focus on the skills to cultivate transformative community-based ministry for the long term.

The Mission on the Margins track recognises a range of marginal contexts. Participants are expected to be involved in leading or resourcing mission in one of the following:

- ♦ Rural communities
- ♦ Post-industrial contexts
- ♦ Urban estates and low-income neighbourhoods
- ♦ Social justice initiatives
- ♦ Work with the homeless and marginalised communities
- ♦ Prisons and social action projects

Our academic awards are validated by Durham University (Common Awards) and include options from St Hild graduate and postgraduate programmes suitable for those with a prior first degree. Non-accredited and non-assessed pathways are available; we welcome enquiries from applicants with limited study experience. Bursary funding may be available.
